The written examination of Customs Brokers Licensing Examination, 2022 shall be conducted by NACIN in the month of MARCH-2022 at the designated examination centers across India. A copy of the regulations is available at www.cbic.gov.in and www.nacin.gov.in .

Complete application is to be submitted in person or by Registered/ Speed Post in Form-A (available in the CBLR, 2018) along with two passport size photos and self-attested documents on citizenship (Aadhaar/ Passport/ Voter Card), educational qualification, financial viability, mobile number, e-mail id and other requirements along with the prescribed fee of Rs. 500/- (Rupees five hundred only) to the Principal Commissioner/ Commissioner of Customs/ Commissioner of Customs (Prev), having jurisdiction over the area where the applicant intends to carry on his business from 18.10.2021 to 18.11.2021 till 06.00 PM. Applications sent by post, in case received after the last date shall not be entertained.

Differently abled Candidates may mention their status along with their application form with supporting documents.

The online written examination will be a Computer Based Exam with Multiple Choice Questions (MCQs) of two and half hours (10:30 hrs to 13:00 hrs) duration. Questions will be bilingual i.e. in English and Hindi. The pattern of the examination will be as follows:

Marking scheme: +3 for each correct answer

-1 for each incorrect answer

Maximum marks: 450

Qualifying marks: 270 (60%)

The syllabus of examination is prescribed in Regulation 6(7) of the Customs Brokers Licensing Regulations, 2018, as amended. Those qualifying in the said examination

The oral examination will be held during the second quarter of the calendar year 2022. The pass percentage marks for qualifying in the oral examination will be 60%.
